Cutting and Joining Tools Resource Sheet

Be sure to wear _____ with all saws, drills and power tools.

A _____ is used to cut wood across the grain of the wood. It is a relatively fast cutting saw, but leaves a pretty rough edge.

A _____ is a lot like a crosscut saw, but it takes longer to use, and gives a smoother cut. It's often used with a mitre box for picture frames, door trim, and other finish type carpentry.

A _____ is used only to cut metal. Be doubly careful to wear _____ when using a hacksaw.

A _____ saw is used to cut curved or irregular lines. DON'T push too hard on this saw, or it will bend the blade.

A _____ is used to cut fabric, cardboard, or foamcore. Make sure the blade is retracted before you put it away.

A _____ is used to round off and shape wood.

An _____ is used to drill holes and install and remove screws.

When putting in a drill bit or screwdriver bit, be sure to _____.

Always _____ a drill bit when you're finished.

If you are using a drill for a power screwdriver, don't _____ after you put it in. It will be hot enough to blister your finger!

Be sure to always _____ the pieces of wood you're drilling through. NEVER hold one piece of wood with your hand or foot.

A _____ is like a power version of a keyhole saw. It will cut straight lines also, but there are 3 things to remember: First... _____. If you force a jigsaw, the blade will break. Secondly... make sure the blade has _____ before you remove it from the cut. And most importantly, _____. If the blade breaks, it can go flying!

The _____ is used to drive and pull nails. Always wear _____ because you are hitting metal, the hammer, against metal, the nail, and little slivers of metal WILL be flying.
